Plant Biology 2020 is a meeting of the American Society of Plant Biologists. The conference will feature five plenary symposia, large poster sessions, 30 concurrent symposia, and select 2-minute Rapid Communication talks comprised primarily of speakers selected by the Program Committee from submitted abstracts.

Abstracts should be submitted in the provided text box in the step-by-step abstract submission process. Submissions cannot be over 300 words and may not include any graphics or tabular material. You do not have to be an ASPB member to submit an abstract.

Please note that a \$50.00 non-refundable abstract submission fee is required for each abstract submission. A payment confirmation code, obtained once the abstract fee has been paid, will be required at the beginning of the submission process. 1 Terms & Conditions *

There is a \$50.00 non-refundable fee required for each abstract submission.

Each individual can submit up to (2) abstract submissions for Plant Biology 2020.

To ensure listing of the abstract in the online program and to receive a poster number, poster presenters must complete abstract submission and conference registration by June 19, 2020.

June 19, 2020 is the deadline for poster presenter submissions to be included in the online program book and to receive a poster number. Individuals who submit a poster abstract must also register for the meeting or their poster will not be included in the online meeting program. Poster presenters must bring a physical poster to the Plant Biology Annual Meeting.

July 17, 2020 is the deadline for late abstract submissions to be included in the app. These posters will not receive a poster number and poster display spots are first come, first served. Primary poster presenters must also be registered for the meeting. This will be the LAST DAY to submit an abstract. Abstracts will not be accepted after this deadline.
