Please ensure that all email addresses of the presenters are accurate, and are the emails associated with your AANA member record. This is very important as this will be the sole method of communication regarding acceptance.
- Abstracts are reviewed and graded blindly by the AANA Track Leaders, as well as AANA invited graders.

The AANA is a non-profit organization. Upon acceptance, presenters will receive free registration to the Leadership Summit 2020. Presenters will be responsible for all travel and accommodations.
