



## CALL FOR ABSTRACTS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

**1. When/where is Rx Summit 2020?**

Rx Summit 2020 will be held April 13-16, 2020, at the Gaylord Opryland Resort & Convention Center in Nashville, Tennessee.

**2. What is the deadline for abstract submissions?**

The deadline for abstract submissions is Friday, August 23, 2019, at 11:59 PM ET.

**3. How can I submit my abstract?**

To submit a session abstract, please visit our submission website and create an account. Follow the instructions provided and be sure to fill out all required fields.

**4. May I include a table with my abstract?**

No tables, figures, or images may be included in the abstract.

**5. How many presenters can be included in a session?**

A maximum of four (4) presenters can be included; however, the Rx Summit will only provide complimentary registration and travel reimbursement in line with our Presentation Terms and Conditions for up to two (2) presenters only. For posters, only one (1) presenter will be allowed.

**6. Can I revise my abstract after it has been submitted?**

You can log back into your account and make changes to your abstract until the submission deadline (August 23).

**7. Is there an abstract submission fee?**

There is no fee to submit a session or poster abstract for the Rx Summit.

**8. What should I do if I would like to withdraw my abstract?**

**9. When and how will I receive notification about the status of my abstract?**

Notification regarding acceptance or denial of abstracts will be sent by email to the primary submitter by November 2019.
