Before You Begin:

Review the information below before you begin:

- We estimate it takes 10-15 minutes to review each proposal. Please plan accordingly.
- This is the first round of review. Further review will take place; the Greenbuilding Brasil Program Working Group will participate in the second round of review.

Before reviewing any proposals, please review, sign and submit the **Greenbuilding Brasil 2017 Reviewer Code of Conduct** (task 1 above).



To begin reviewing session proposals, click on 'Click here to begin reviewing' (task 2 above). The system will take you to the first review to be completed, or if you have already begun the process, it will automatically advance you to the next proposal you need to review.

Click on 'View a summary of your reviews' to see all the proposals assigned to you and the scores that you entered. Clicking on any of the titles will bring you to the Scorecard for that proposal.

Navigation:

There are two basic ways to navigate within the Abstract Scorecard:

1. The arrow keys at the top of the scorecard will allow you to navigate through the proposals.

2. The 'Picker' at the bottom of the scorecard will allow you to 'jump' to any specific proposal assigned to you.

Review Summary:



This icon, positioned next to the arrow keys, allows you to review the scores you have already entered in addition to all the proposals assigned to you.

You can change the order that the proposals appear in the Review Summary (pictured below) by clicking on the column headings in order to sort them by ID and Title. Once sorted, the abstracts will appear in this order when grading resumes.




REVIEW SUMMARY
