Required Information:

Presenter, Co-presenter, Panelist Information

Note: You will need to be able to complete the following information for all presenters in your proposal.

- ✓ Contact Information: address, email address
- ✓ Organization, title, and personal bio (max 60 words)
- ✓ Past conferences where s/he has presented
- ✓ If s/he has not presented at an ACI/HPC event two times over the past three years, two or more references with their contact information
- ✓ Optional: photo

- √ 3 learning objectives (that complete the sentence, "By attending this session, participants will...")
- √ Keywords (max of 15)
