

SCIENTIFIC SESSION APPLICATION NUTRITION 2018 (June 9-12, 2018 · Hynes Convention Center · Boston, MA) Applications due July 20, 2017 All proposals must be submitted online via the Nutrition 2018 Submission Platform accessible at www.nutrition.org/n18.

The American Society for Nutrition is excited to launch **Nutrition 2018**, a premier global platform for researchers, clinicians, public health professionals and other stakeholders interested in the advancement and application of nutrition science.

We are currently soliciting suggestions for sessions to be conducted as part of the official scientific program. For the current call for sessions, suggestions are being sought for the following types of sessions:

<u>Scientific Symposia</u>: These 90-120 minute sessions are focused on exciting, "hot" or emerging areas of nutrition research and/or practice. These sessions may feature three or more presentations and panel discussions.

<u>Core Symposia</u>: These 90 minute sessions are intended to focus on topics that evoke interest across disciplines – basic, clinical and public health scientists. The topic may reside outside the field of nutrition but be of interest to nutrition researchers. Multiple speakers (e.g., up to three) may be included.

<u>Plenary Lectures</u>: Targeted to all session attendees, plenary lectures are reserved for presentations by preeminent researchers whose work is highly regarded. The topic may or may not be directly related to nutrition but it may impact the field of nutrition or otherwise be important to the scientific community. These lectures should be approximately 30-40 minutes in length.

Controversy Sessions: These sessions feature two or more speakers presenting opposing views followed by discussion.

Criteria for these sessions include the following:

- Excellence of science
- Novel, timely topics
- Balanced, objective programming
- Multi-disciplinary appeal
- Preeminent speakers, including individuals on the frontier of scientific disciplines that may or may not be traditionally associated with nutrition
- Diversity across institution, gender, race/ethnicity and/or career stage in chairs and speakers.

<u>Please note that additional opportunities for submitting content for Nutrition 2018 will be available in September</u>. These include:

- Abstracts for oral and poster presentations
- Partner sessions (e.g., international nutrition societies, other scientific and medical organizations, government)
- Sponsored Satellite Programs
- Professional and/or Career Development Workshops
- ASN Community (RIS/Council) Forums

A few things to note:

- ✓ Given the number of high quality submissions that we receive each year, we are unable to accept each proposal; in fact, we typically accept no more than 20% of the submissions.
- ✓ Often, ASN's Scientific Program Committee may recommend modifications to proposals, particularly if multiple proposals on similar topics are received. For these reason, your suggested speakers do not need to be confirmed.
- ✓ Speaker reimbursement will follow ASN's revised Speaker Reimbursement Policy:

ASN Member Speakers

- Meeting registration
- Member speakers outside of North America: Up to \$1,000 in travel reimbursement.
- Domestic member speakers: No travel reimbursement. ASN members are expected to participate in ASN's annual meeting as supportive proponents of the Society.

ASN Nonmember Speakers

- Meeting registration
- Travel reimbursement (e.g., airfare, hotel and per diem for 1-3 nights depending on timing of session and speaker residence) to be capped at \$1,000 (North American speakers) and \$2,500 (speakers residing outside North America).
