To that end, we have simplified the submission and review process. The submission and review process will be conducted in two phases:

- □ In <u>Phase 1</u> candidates will submit a thesis statement and describe their planned learner engagement; these proposals will be rated based on emerging trends, new ideas, engaging learning, and knowledge level.
- □ In <u>Phase 2</u> candidates will provide learner outcomes, speaker expertise, and post-convention value to attendees; proposals will be rated based on these elements.

All proposals will be rated, ranked and selected by the Convention Education Peer Review Team. Please refer to the table below to review action items and related deadlines.
