All poster proposals must be submitted online:

Submission of a proposal is an acknowledgement that all presenters agree to:

- Limit your submissions to the number of posters you feel you are able to prepare by April 15, 2015
- Be listed in the website, program book, and on-site materials.
- Supply any required additional information in a timely manner as requested.
- Submit a properly formatted poster to ICISF by deadline. Guidelines for preparation of your poster will be supplied to lead presenter upon notification that their poster has been accepted.

If you plan on registering and participating in the World Congress, there will be an OPTIONAL Poster Presentation Session on Saturday, May 16.

Proposal review process

Reviewers will consider:

1. Whether sufficient information has been supplied in the proposal for the reviewers to understand the topic, content and purpose/objectives of the poster;
2. The relevance of the proposed poster to the identified target audience;
3. Whether the poster reflects current evidence-based guidelines for crisis intervention practice;
4. Timeliness of the application of crisis intervention principles;
5. Whether the poster covers an innovative concept or approach.
