

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS for PODIUM PRESENTATIONS

Fall National Neonatal/Advanced Practice/Mother Baby Nurses Conference Las Vegas, Nevada • September 9–12, 2020

SPONSORED BY THE ACADEMY OF NEONATAL NURSING

The Academy of Neonatal Nursing is seeking podium abstracts to complement our lineup of expert speakers. We invite submissions for 20-minute oral presentations in keeping with our focus of examining current neonatal nursing practice. Clinical, case study, and research abstracts are welcome. The topics for these abstracts should be relevant to the purpose of the conference and the audience of neonatal nurses.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Log on to the <u>ANN Portal</u> to begin the submission process
- Complete the five required tasks and be sure and Submit after task completion
- A Conflict of Interest Form must be submitted by all coauthors (included in submission tasks)
- Presentations are welcome in three categories:
 - Innovative Programs: Describe a program implemented in your practice setting which addresses challenges in nursing practice, education, or administration in neonatal and mother baby care.
 - Research: Describe original research or knowledge translation. Include a
 description of the following: Statement of the problem, conceptual
 framework (if applicable), literature review, methodology, and data
 analysis and interpretation.
 - Case Studies: Describe the infant's diagnosis, including incidence and etiology; an overview of the diagnostic process; management; discussion of outcomes; and implications for practice. The case discussion must comply with HIPAA regulations. The case must not be in litigation.

General Podium (oral presentation) Information:

- Each submission will be blind peer-reviewed by a minimum of three neonatal nurses.
- Each podium presentation will be limited to 20 minutes (including questions).
- Podium presenters will be provided with an LCD projector, screen, and lectern with microphone. No other audio/visual equipment will be provided or may be used.

Writing Your Abstract:

- Abstracts must avoid any semblance of commercialism; those constituting promotion and advertising are prohibited.
- Abstracts must be limited to 200 words.
- Do not include references in your abstract.

- State unit of measurement for lab results.
- Spell out the first use of any acronym, e.g., large for gestational age (LGA)
- You must submit one learner objective.

All presenters are required to register and attend the full conference. All presenters are responsible for their own travel and all expenses related to their presentation. Podium presenters receive a \$100 discount off main conference tuition. This discount is offered to the primary presenter only and cannot be combined with any other discount.
