### SPONSORED BY THE ACADEMY OF NEONATAL NURSING

The Academy of Neonatal Nursing is seeking poster presentations to complement our line-up of expert speakers. In keeping with our theme of examining current practice, we invite you to submit a poster abstract. Clinical, case study, and research posters are welcome. The topics for these posters should be relevant to the purpose of the conference and the audience of neonatal nurses.

### POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Log on to the <u>ANN Portal</u> to begin the submission process
- Complete the five required tasks and be sure and **Submit** after task completion
- A Conflict of Interest Form must be submitted by all coauthors (included in submission tasks)
- Posters must avoid any semblance of commercialism; those constituting promotion and advertising are prohibited.
- Each submission will be blind peer-reviewed by a minimum of three neonatal nurses.
- All presenters are required to register and attend the full conference.
- The poster hall will be virtual and available online only.
- Presenters are required to upload a PDF file of their poster
- Presenters are required to upload an audio file describing the content (instructions for recording will be provided)
- Attendees will earn contact hours for viewing and evaluating posters.

**Innovative Programs**: Describe a program implemented in your practice setting which addresses challenges in nursing practice, education, or administration in neonatal care.

**Research**: Describe original research or knowledge translation. Include a description of the following: Statement of the problem, conceptual framework (if applicable), literature review, methodology, and data analysis and interpretation.

**Case Studies**: Describe the infant's diagnosis, including incidence and etiology; an overview of the diagnostic process; management; discussion of outcomes; and implications for practice. The case discussion must comply with HIPAA regulations. The case must not be in litigation.

### POSTER CONTENT GUIDELINES

As you prepare your poster for presentation, please keep the following guidelines in mind:

- 1. Ensure that the names and credentials of all authors are correctly spelled and listed in the correct order. The poster abstracts will be published in the Conference Proceedings section of *Neonatal Network:*® *The Journal of Neonatal Nursing*. Because abstracts are due before the conferences, we often refer to the poster itself to ensure we have the correct author(s) and credentials.
- 2. For research abstracts, be sure and include categories as outlined above.
- 3. Proofread your poster to ensure that each sentence makes sense and there are no spelling errors.
- 4. All presenters are required to register and attend the full conference

Abstracts for poster presentations are due July 31, 2020.
