





VIVA Submission Guidelines

Abstract submissions should address areas of endovascular medicine.

- Clinical studies
- Basic science investigations
- Pre-clinical studies

Research must be original and may not have been presented prior to presentation at VIVA if selected.

Abstract must include:

- Trial name
- Purpose
- Materials and Methods
- Results
- Conclusions
- Total abstract length may not exceed 2,500 characters excluding title

Abstract submission fields:

- Submitter
 - Primary Contact name
 - Organization/institution
 - o Phone number
 - E-mail address
- Authors up to 3
- Presenter
 - o E-mail
 - o Phone number
- Research supported/funded by: Company or entity name
- Six-word title for abstract presentation

Scoring Criteria – Scale of 1-10 with 10 being highest

Interest to Field Research Method Quality of Data Primary endpoint presented

Overview of process

Submissions open as soon as possible

Abstracts are submitted – close date June 30 Expect approximately 40 abstracts
We will have 5 reviewers
Abstracts will be scored July – 1 through 17
Accepted abstracts will be notified July 22
