## **Presenter Qualifications and Guidance**

Due to Continuing Education requirements, presenters are limited to 3 per workshop and 1 presenter must have a master's degree or above. There are three ways that this can occur while still honoring the focus on individual, family and staff/provider issues and best practices:

- 1. You may have an individual with lived experience, a family member or DSP/Provider staff in your organization who also has a degree.
- 2. You may know someone in your state or another organization who works closely with you on these issues who is willing to partner with you.
- 3. NADD can assist in connecting you with someone who has a degree and involvement in the topic you propose.

NADD values the involvement and voice of individuals with disabilities, their families and direct support professionals and is committed to the inclusion of topics relevant to these groups and highlighting the success of these groups. If you are interested in presenting and are a part of one of these groups, please look into whether option 1 or 2 is available and then plan for including the identified individual. If you need to use option 3 and need assistance from NADD, then please limit your presenters to 2 individuals and note in your submission that this assistance will be needed.
