PHM Abstract & Conundrums Submission FAQs

Can I submit an abstract that I have already submitted to another competition/congress/annual meeting?

Yes, PHM will accept abstracts and/or conundrums that have been presented elsewhere. Please note that abstracts or conundrums that have been PUBLISHED cannot be submitted for consideration. PHM (SHM, APA & AAP) does not hold the copyright to the abstract and/or conundrum, so you are welcome to submit to other competitions/congresses happening after PHM.

Do I have to be an SHM, AAP or APA member to submit an abstract?

No, however if your submission is accepted, you will be required to register for the meeting to present your abstract or conundrum at the PHM 2022 Meeting in Lake Buena Vista, FL, July 28 - 31, 2022. Please note that non-member registration prices are higher than member prices.

Is this year's competition virtual?

No, this year's event will be held live in Lake Buena Vista, FL at the Disney Yacht & Beach Club, July 28 – 31, 2022. All abstract & conundrum presenters, whether it is oral presentation or poster presentation, will need to attend in-person in order to participate.

How much does it cost to submit?

There is no fee to submit and abstract or conundrum. However, please keep in mind that if your submission is accepted, all presenters must register to attend the PHM 2022 Meeting. Registration fees for the meeting are not reduced or waived for abstract and conundrum presenters.

Is there a word limit?

Yes, there is a 2,600-character limit on abstracts and conundrum submissions. The system calculates the character count and will notify the user if the submission is over the character limit. Attached tables and references are not included in the character limit. Tables and reference should be included as an attachment in order for it to not count in the character-limit.

Can I submit multiple abstracts or conundrums?

Yes, you can submit multiple abstracts or conundrums. There is no limit on the number of abstracts that can be submitted for consideration.

Can I submit both an abstract AND a conundrum?

Yes, you can submit both abstracts and conundrums in the submission system.

I am a resident; can I submit an abstract or conundrum?

Yes, anyone can submit an abstract or conundrum. All submitters are encouraged to review the submission guidelines thoroughly before submitting an abstract or conundrum to ensure it fits all necessary criteria.

I'd like to review abstracts and/or conundrums at PHM 2022; can I submit an abstract and/or conundrum if I'm a reviewer?

Yes, reviewing does not preclude you from submitting an abstract.

I'd like to review abstracts and/or conundrums at PHM 2022; can I sign up to be a reviewer?

Yes, the call for reviewers for both abstracts & conundrums will be sent out in early February 2022.
