The CANS Program Committee is seeking volunteers from the CANS membership to serve as abstract reviewers. In this role, you will ensure that the best and most timely research is presented at the virtual 2023 Advanced Methods Conference. Abstract authors are eligible to serve as reviewers. *CANS reviewers must be current members of CANS and have a research-focused doctorate degree.*

The abstract review period will take place from **May – June 2023**. Each reviewer will be assigned abstracts based on their expertise. CANS anticipates assigning each reviewer an estimate of 10 abstracts (based on need). All reviews will be completed in the online system Cadmium.
