Your speaker bio (maximum of 75 words) should include your current title/position, company/organization, any designations you may have, followed by your core work experience and professional highlights. You may include academic qualifications, awards, honors and reference to published work if applicable to the material you're presenting. *Note: Bios should be crafted to highlight experience pertinent to the proposal they support.*
