

SAWC ABSTRACT PRESENTATIONS

Oral Abstract Presentations:

Podium presentations will feature the highest-scoring abstract submissions, wishing to be considered for oral presentation:

- Submissions with a preference for “oral only” or “poster if not selected for oral” will be considered for podium presentation.
- Submissions with a preference for “oral only” will not be given special consideration.
- Submissions with a preference for “poster only” will not be considered for oral presentation.

Primary contacts (submitters) of these abstracts will be notified individually of selection for podium presentation by the acceptance/decline deadline. Abstracts selected for podium presentation will be notified individually. Podium presenters are also invited to present their abstract, in poster form, during the poster session if they desire.

A minimum of three (3) submissions will be selected for podium presentation. Each presenter will have 5 minutes to present key results of their research, followed by 5 minutes for Q&A time with the audience at the end of the session, animated by the experts chairing the session.

Poster Grand Rounds:

SAWC Poster Grand Rounds is a walking session, where attendees will have the ability to interact directly with authors over their research. Posters selected for the Grand Rounds session will be staged in a designated ‘Grand Rounds Section’ of the Poster Hall.

During this session, Moderators will be walking with a group of conference attendees reviewing selected posters. Poster presenters/authors for Grand Rounds selected posters are expected to be present during this session to provide a 3-5-minute summary of their project/poster.

Moderators will monitor questions from the audience after each presentation. The interaction is meant to be collegial, not critical, with the goal of attendees learning from the authors experience and project.

Poster Presentation:

- Posters are typically displayed on a 4' high x 8' wide bulletin board. Posters should fit within those dimensions. We recommend printing your physical poster in 40" high x 60" wide.
- Push pins will be provided. If you need additional mounting supplies, especially with heavier posters (laminated, vinyl, or other heavier material), please bring them with you
- The distribution of product samples is prohibited
- Handouts and business cards may be distributed
- Audio-visual equipment will not be available for poster presentations
