This is a preview of the application. Applicants must register online and submit all proposals via the online portal for consideration. The application takes 10-15 minutes to complete. To support ADA compliance, most media formats are accepted for submission. If submitting a video, limit the length to 1 min max.

Presentation Format

- Choose from five (5) programming formats for submission and consideration. Select all that apply:
 - Virtual pre-recorded one hour CEU session – professionally produced, video content available to NeoCon participants, beginning June 10th via the NeoCon Learning Hub.
 - On-site CEU presentation to a live NeoCon audience– recorded on-site and provided for registrants one week post NeoCon on the Learning Hub.
 - Long-form, 2–4-hour, experiential workshop for direct, practice-based learning for a live NeoCon audience.
 - NeoCon Talks – 20 min live, conversational presentations on the 7th Floor Exhibit Hall at NeoCon.
 - On-site programming at THE MART throughout the 2024 calendar year.
