Criteria Used to Judge Abstracts	Do you have this information to include in your abstracts?	I am ready!
Basis of inquiry/ Intro (Are you hooked?)	You can identify the problem and rationale for chosen direction or approach	<input type="checkbox"/>
Purpose/objective/Aim (Do they jump out?)	You can clearly state the purpose/objective/aims – this needs to be a sentence that can jump out at the reader	<input type="checkbox"/>
Methods (What, who, how?)	You can clearly state how you did your project and these should relate to the purpose/objective <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If research project: you can describe design, sample, how you measured <b>outcomes</b>, if there was an intervention, what it was, and how you analyzed results</li> <li>• If QI/EBP project: you can explain what you did to change a system (the intervention) and how you measured <b>outcomes</b></li> <li>• If educational project: you can describe the educational intervention, who was focus of intervention, and how learner <b>outcomes</b> were measured</li> </ul>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Findings/Outcomes (What did you find/what does it mean?)	Logically and concisely stated and relate to stated objectives/aims and methods . <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If research: Present summary results (outcomes) and comment on how this may influence nursing practice.</li> <li>• If QI/EBP: Present outcomes of project and implications for practice</li> <li>• If Education: Summarize outcomes of the educational program</li> </ul>	<input type="checkbox"/>
Content Relevance	Relevant to pediatric hematology/oncology nursing?	<input type="checkbox"/>

Note: The word **“outcomes”** is bolded throughout this worksheet. That is because, you need to include outcomes in your abstract. If your project is in process and you don't have any outcomes yet; consider waiting for the call for “Late Breaking Abstracts” and submit when you do have outcomes or wait until next year.
