The [Southern Group on Educational Affairs \(SGEA\)](#), Student Affairs (SGSA), and Organization of Student Representatives (SOSR) invites abstracts for interactive workshops, oral abstract presentations, small group discussions, panels, and posters for the 2025 SGEA/SGSA/SOSR Annual Conference which will be held in-person in Miami, FL in late April 28-30, 2025. Abstract proposals may represent original research in medical education or innovations in medical education. Abstracts can focus on any level of medical education (UME pre clerkship or clerkship, GME, CME/CPD, SPACE, Admissions, Student Affairs, Student Diversity Affairs, Student Financial Assistance, Student Records, Advising, Learners? Experiences and Initiatives, or across the continuum).

All proposals will undergo a peer-review process. Students, residents, fellows, new investigators, and colleagues from historically non-majority backgrounds are strongly encouraged to submit their work for consideration.

Abstracts must be submitted online no later than Change: **11:59pm CST October 21, 2024.**

We recommend that you prepare your proposal in a word processing application and then paste each component into the corresponding online section. A submission is considered a commitment to attend the meeting and present if accepted. Submission decisions will be sent to the first author in February 2025.
