## **Submission Categories**

#### Research

Abstracts submitted in this category should report completed research studies relevant to Heart Failure treatment and patient care. Submissions should include background, aim, methods results, and conclusion.

Your submission will include a Background, Aim, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.

### **Quality Improvement**

Abstracts submitted in this category should summarize/document a creative and/or novel advance in the care and/or management of patients with heart failure. Submissions should include background, purpose, setting/ population, Method/Process, Outcome Measures, and Practical Implications.

Your submission will include Background, Purpose, Setting/Population, Method/Process, Outcome Measures, and Practical Implications.

#### **Submission Notes**

- High-scoring abstracts accepted for presentation and moderated poster will be published in Heart & Lung: The Journal of Acute and Critical Care
- AAHFN welcomes abstracts previously submitted to other national or international meetings
- Authors may submit an unlimited number of abstracts
- Submitted Abstracts will be peer reviewed
- Abstracts may be accepted for oral or poster presentation
