NeoCon 2026 CEU & Workshop Application Preview

To support ADA compliance, most media formats are accepted for submission. If submitting a video, limit the length to 2GB.

- Choose from three (3) programming formats for submission and consideration. Select your preferred format from the drop-down menu and complete the application. Applicants may now submit their presentation across multiple formats via the “Consider other formats” task.
 - Virtual pre-recorded one hour CEU session – professionally produced, video content available to NeoCon participants, beginning June 8 via the NeoCon CEU Hub.
 - On-site CEU presentation to a live NeoCon audience - also pre-recorded and offered as a virtual CEU.
 - Long-form, 1.5-2-hour, experiential workshop for direct, practice-based learning for a live NeoCon audience.
