2. The presenter affirms that the content submitted represents their own original work, expertise, research, programmatic practices, or the work of the agency, organization, institution, or school district they represent. The presenter further affirms that the materials do not improperly use or reproduce the intellectual property, copyrighted work, or proprietary content of another party without appropriate permission or attribution.
3. Presenters agree that all information submitted as part of the proposal process is accurate and complete to the best of their knowledge.
4. Submission of a proposal does not guarantee acceptance into the conference program.
5. If selected, presenters acknowledge that their session is not considered a keynote, featured speaker, or compensated speaking engagement. Presenters and co-presenters will not receive payment, honoraria, stipends, or speaker fees from NAEHCY for participation in the conference.
